

How to find AstraZeneca Brixham

Brixham is one of the three towns around Torbay, in South Devon in the UK. It is a picturesque town with an historic harbour, where fishing has been the main industry for hundreds of years. More local information can be found on the Torbay council website (<http://www.torbay.gov.uk/home.asp>). The AstraZeneca Brixham Environmental Laboratory site is located adjacent to the town centre, overlooking the outer harbour.



Travel

Brixham is readily accessible by road and rail and from local airports at Exeter and Plymouth, both less than an hour's drive away. Brittany Ferries (<http://www.brittany-ferries.com/>) also operate a car ferry linking Plymouth to Roscoff, France and to Santander, Spain.

By Air

Airports at nearby Exeter (<http://www.eclipse.co.uk/exeterair/>) and Plymouth (<http://www.plymouthcity.co.uk/airport.html>) are linked by flights from some locations in the UK and some European cities.

By Rail

The nearest main line station is at Newton Abbot, with direct trains to London Paddington and the North of England. Your Brixham contact will be pleased to arrange a taxi to collect you from the station.

By Road

From London or the North:

- Take the M5 South to the end of the motorway, and continue beyond Exeter on the A38 dual carriageway.
- At the A38/A380 fork, take the left-hand A380 towards Torbay (the right-hand fork can also be taken for a slightly longer route via Totnes).
- At the large “Penn Inn” roundabout at Newton Abbot, continue on the A380 towards Torquay.
- At the next roundabout, on the outskirts of Torquay, turn right to follow the A380 Ring Road up “Hamlin Way”.
- Continue along the Ring Road past Paignton and follow the signs for Brixham.

From Plymouth and the West:

- Take the A38 towards Exeter.
- Leave the A38 at the sign for the A385 to Totnes.
- Continue on the A385 towards Paignton.
- At the traffic light junction with the A3022 Ring Road, turn right to take the A3022 to Brixham.

On arriving at the only set of traffic lights in the town centre, take a left turn and follow the main road, keeping the inner harbour to your left. With the fish market directly ahead, follow

the sharp left bend in the road up Overgang Road. At the hairpin bend, turn right into Blackball Lane, towards Freshwater Quarry car park. When you approach the car park, you will clearly see the entrance to AstraZeneca Brixham directly ahead, where you can check in at the Security Gate.
