

**A DECLARATION OF COLLABORATIVE WORKING BETWEEN The North East And
Cumbria AHSN and Astra Zeneca UK Ltd.**

BACKGROUND

The North East and Cumbria AHSN and AstraZeneca are engaged in a Joint Working Project entitled Cardio Renal Secondment

The project will run from June 2022 to June 2023

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Heart failure & CKD is often miscoded in primary care creating unequitable access to functional assessment reviews and optimisation for patients living with the condition.

CDRC Precision digital resources are developed by clinicians in the North East of England, working on existing clinical IT systems (SystemOne and EMIS) and are quality assured by the North of England Care Support Unit (NECS).

Through seconding a Regional Healthcare Manager to NENC AHSN one day per week, they will project manage the development of CDRC for Heart Failure & CKD and subsequent deployment to pilot sites to validate the resource.

Collaborative Working Aims and Objectives:

- 1. Improve performance management by proactively managing Quality and Outcomes Framework targets for HF and CKD**
